

President, Heidi Allison:

- Discussed Society of Decorative Painters. Lawyer sent second letter. Still no response from SDP.
- Foundation has wheels in motion to sell art. There will be a new SDP vision if it goes to the foundation. Looks like certificates are going away. Most chapters appear to be leaving.
- Have received lots of positive feedback regarding our chapter.

Treasurer, Jolene Cooley:

- We currently have a balance of \$12,186.00. We have made money on every program, even the zoom classes, since Covid. Our chapter is healthy and in a strong position.

HERITAGE HOLIDAY BOUTIQUE GUIDELINES

Welcome to the Gypsy Toler's Annual Heritage Sale. We hope you have been busy painting lots of wonderful items to put in the sale!

Be sure to mark your calendars to bring your painted goods and share in the good times with your fellow Gypsy Tolers.

WHEN: Sunday, November 13, 2022

WHERE: 10 E. State Street, Suite 200

Redlands, CA 92373

DROP OFF TIME: Vendors must be there at 7 am to start setting up for the sale.

WORK SCHEDULE: VENDORS MUST REMAIN ONSITE ALL DAY DURING THE SALE.

PICK UP TIME: Sunday, November 13, 2021 at 4:15 pm. You may not start shutting down or

cleaning up before this time.

COST: Registration Fee (non-refundable): \$25 for Gypsy Toler members; \$35 for

non-members; PLUS 10% of sales for both members and non-members.

SELLER RESPONSIBILITY:

Set up day of sale, work all day during the sale, take down/clean up at end of sale.

- Sellers wanting their own table are responsible for table covering.
- Use price tags provided or something similar. Use blue or black ink. Make sure your price tags are
 affixed securely to each item.
- Sign and return Seller Agreement.
- Invite family, friends, co-workers, neighbors, etc. to attend the Boutique.

CHAPTER RESPONSIBILITY:

- Provide tables, pegboards and Christmas trees to display items.
- Calculate, collect and pay sales tax to the State Board of Equalization on behalf of all vendors.
- Provide price tags to vendors who request them.
- Reconcile vendor gross and net sales. Issue check for net sales to individual vendor.

Education Hints from...:

Bonnie Dominguez

- 1. Any brush can become a dry brush...just do NOT use any water!
- Clean stencils with hand sanitizer.
- 3. If brushing glitter on smaller areas—use "Twinkles"...it is a nicely sized glitter.
- 4. When using SoSoft paints—less water is more. Only use SoSoft medium when you want a transparent look or mix with SoSoft paint if putting a glaze over another color.
- 5. Paint the back of your piece and put on one application of Final Coat to protect it against scratches, scuffs, etc. May paint or varnish if you wish over the fFnal Coat barrier if you wish later.
- 6. Always paint a green under a red base coat—Light Hauser Green or possibly Foliage Green.


I am in the planning phase of setting up programs for 2023. If there is a particular teacher or technique you feel would make a great class, I am all ears. I'd just need contact information.
