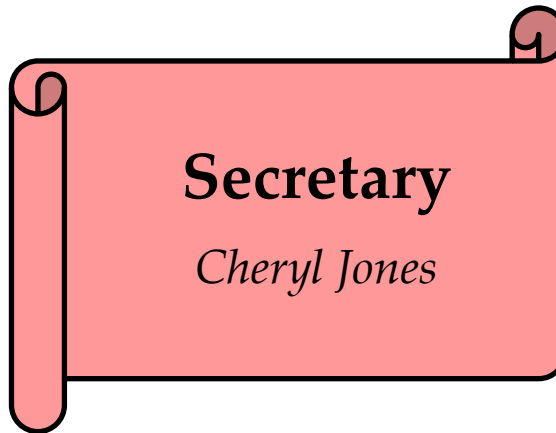

Gypsy Tolers Board Meeting  
February 8, 2021

The Board meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm on Monday, February 8, 2021 by President Judy Coates.

**Kim Tamiazzo—Programs:** Reported that we have 40 signed up for the class in February and as of this date, 10 are signed up for May. PayPal has been set up and is now linked to our banking account for members to use to pay for classes. The Chapter is absorbing the fee due to not having to pay rent at this time. Jan Sunny shared that the Senior Center is not planning to reopen any-time soon so for now we will do classes on Zoom.

**Jan Sunny—Charities:** Reported that we cannot collect used clothing for Angel's Closet because of clothes cleaning issues. She can accept cash and will shop for new clothes if anyone would like to donate. We can still do memory boxes if anyone has them; but there has been an issue finding them right now.

**Carol Whitton—Membership:** Reported that we have 59 members with verified SDP memberships and 14 members not yet verified. Please make sure that you join SDP and give that information to Carol. At this time, the total membership is 73. It was brought up to add emergency information to our membership book. There was an incident at another chapter that prompted this request; the Board agreed to doing this.

**Jolene Cooley—Treasurer:** Reported that we should keep the current budget in place and not require a new budget due to the current climate. The Chapter is doing well financially and very little has changed in the amount we have in the Bank. The financial report is published every month in the newsletter for review.

**Carm Brooker—Ways and Means:** Reported it's hard to have a raffle if we do not meet in person. It was discussed to go ahead and have raffles since PayPal is set up to accept payment; the winner would receive the prize via mail. It was discussed to add pictures of the raffle being offered when the program is announced.

**Ginny Gilman—Historian:** Reported that she has two pages completed. More will happen when we meet again.

**Nancy Schatz—Newsletter:** Reported no issues with the newsletter. If anyone is having problems receiving their newsletter, please let her know.

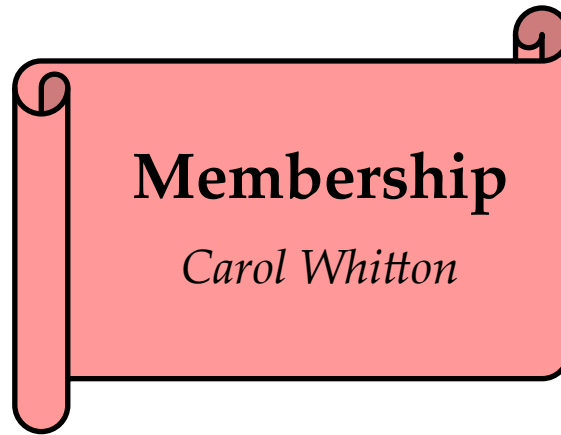
**County Fair:** At this time, the fair will not take place in 2021.

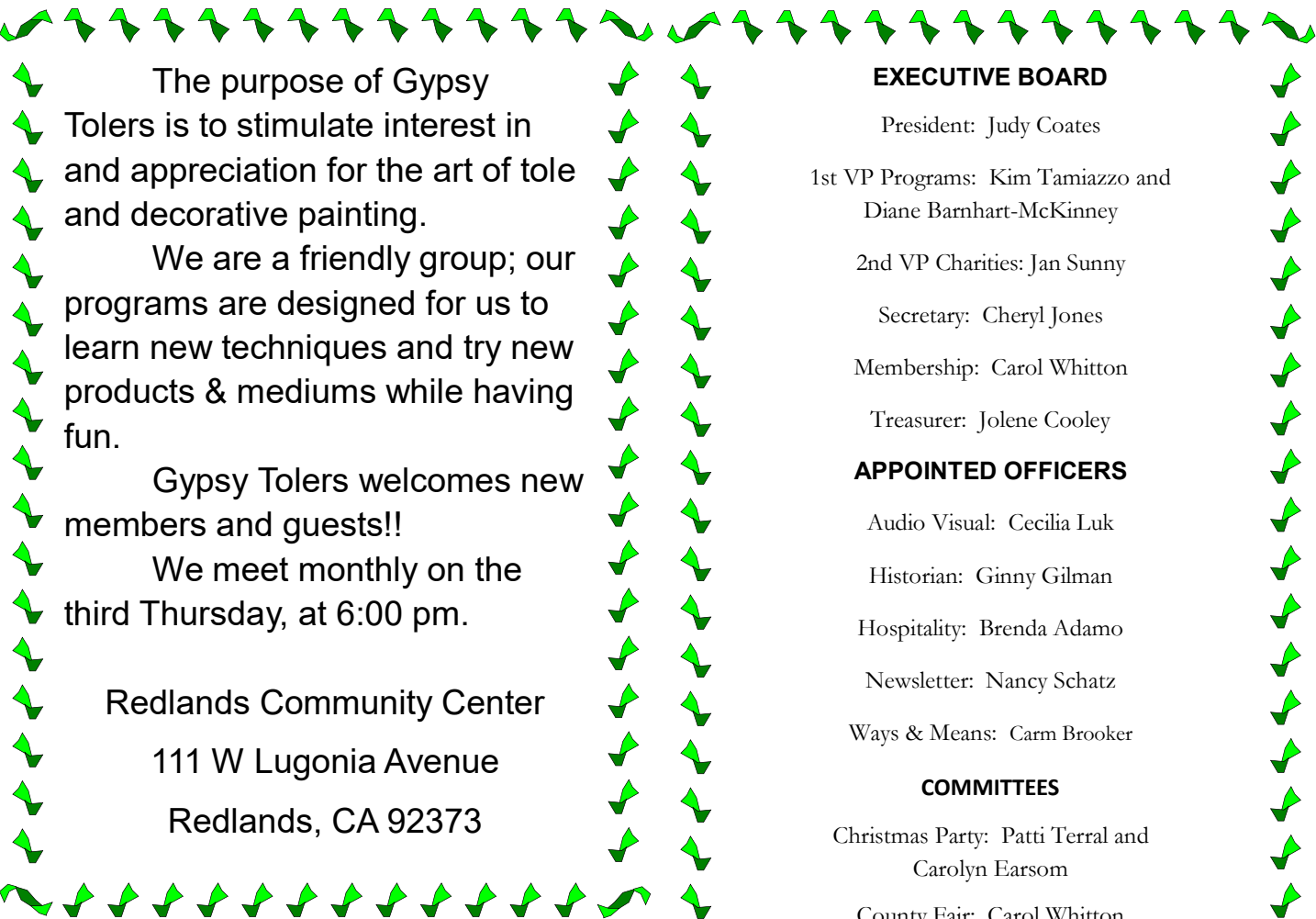
