

President, Heidi Allison:

LapTop: Our new laptop was purchased. The price came in around \$800.00 with tax.

- Cash Register: Approval came in for the cash register. Cecilia Luk is working on finding a cash register that will run an accurate Z report. We will be standardizing tags for all future Heritage sales.
- Spring Exchange: 28 members have signed up so far. Heidi will be sending out the rules again. It's so nice to see lots of friends being made throughout our guild.
- Spring Event: We are working on a name and theme for our function. Committee is coming together. We have 4 teachers; Liz Vigliotto, Heidi Allison, Janet Mitchell, and Judy Coates. The food will be catered as this takes place in lieu of a summer sleepover. The event will be zoomed and in person. Our site looks to be the Burrage Mansion. Looking to be a 2 day event. Friday night and all day Saturday. All teachers will receive kits and will not be charged. Committee members will receive 50% off. We are finalizing dates and working on a price.
 Fall Function: We also plan on hosting a fall function. Tentative date has been set for 10/21/23.

Programs, Carol Whitton:

Programs are all set for the year. We have received many compliments on our set up. I am being contacted by teachers who would like to teach the following year. We usually have 20-30 participants in each program.San Bernardino Fair: All members are encouraged to set aside projects to submit this year to the fair.
