

# HAVE YOU EVER THOUGHT ABOUT ENTERING A PROJECT IN THE SAN BERNARINO COUNTY FAIR?

Both Gypsy Tolers (Advanced and Professional) and Desert Quail Tolers (Novice and Intermediate) sponsor the San Bernardino County Fair in Victorville and strongly urge their members to participate in this fun experience; it can also be quite a learning adventure as you see how others look at various projects you have done and see the beauty and talent in what we ourselves may not have the confidence to see. Here is a bit of information on the upcoming San Bernardino County Fair "rules" and just how to go about entering a piece in the Fair.

First, each year read the specific details of the year's entry process and deadline. You are responsible for determining the department, division and class your piece(s) belongs in — remember if you have been painting for more than 3 years, you should not enter in the novice division. It is not fair for those who have just started painting to compete against a more experienced painter. Also, remember you are not limited to only one entry, but you must pay for each entry you submit. Our tole painting projects are in the "Crafts-Porcelain Dolls-Woodworking-Porcelain Art" Category; the Department is "Crafts"; the Division is based upon your painting experience—"Decorative Painting Novice" (0 to 3 years painting experience), "Decorative Painting Intermediate" (4 to 9 years painting experience), "Decorative Painting Advanced" (10 years or more painting experience) and "Decorative Painting Professional" (anyone who paints as a livelihood—all of our wonderful teachers would be in this category). You would then choose the Class your piece would be in and this year there are 33 different classes you can possibly enter into, but remember to try not to enter two pieces in the same class as you would then be competing against yourself. It might be better to enter fewer items and spend your time making those items special to represent your painting skill to its best advantage.

Next, when choosing your entry think about the things that the judges are looking for to help you look at your piece objectively. Percentages are assigned based upon four specific areas - 25% overall appearance, 35% finish, 20% difficulty factor and 20% for originality and creativity. Judgments are made while considering the specific Division your piece is entered in —f or example, judges would expect a professional to enter a far more difficult piece than a novice. However, all of us are expected to know the basics like being sure the back of all pieces is painted or stained and that the finish on our piece is smooth.

The cost of each entry is \$2.00 for the adult division and the deadline for entry submission is April 10, 2020 up to 4 pm. Fees must accompany each entry; you can enter either online at https://sberna.fairwire.com/exhibitor.aspx?force=Trueor with an entry form available at their website. Entries will be received at the fairgrounds on April 26 or 37, 2020 between 3-7 pm and they must then be picked up on June 1, 2020 between 3-7 pm. Cash awards based upon the judging results may also be claimed on the June 1st after your pick up your piece.

Now that you know the basic rules, let's get to painting and really show the community and our fellow artists





This event is always full of fantastic classes, food, fun, friendship, a great raffle and lots of laughter!

We would like to invite you to submit projects to teach at the Get-Away. Classes will be held Wednesday through Friday and are for all levels of painters. Submissions using various painting mediums (acrylics, oils, watercolors, pencils, mixed media, etc.) are welcome. Here are the details:

- Submissions are due April 10, 2020
- To submit: Email a high-resolution image (jpeg format) and project description information sheet (see next page) for
  each submission to <u>ceceliapaints@aol.com</u> with <u>AGA Teacher Submission</u> in the subject line of the email. We recommend your project photo be taken with proper lighting, contrasting background and full-frame (as close-up as possible with minimal background showing). Up to 3 photos per project may be submitted to show all project sides.
- If you are unable to submit your project by email, please mail a 4" x 6" quality photo and project description information sheet (see next page) to: Cecelia Denton

- **Project selection**: Projects are voted on by the Brush Whacker members and the projects that receive the most votes are offered at the Get-Away.
- **Project fee**: For all classes that are selected, teachers are required to provide students with prepped surfaces, patterns, instructions, photos, class paint and any materials needed to complete the project (i.e., glue, DecoPage, screws, hanging wire, material for bows, etc.). Teachers should include the cost of these items in their project fee. Project fees are paid directly to teachers by their students at the Get-Away.
- **Specialty items**: Teachers should list any specialty items students need to bring to class on the project description information sheet. Teachers may sell specialty items (stencils, stamps, brushes, etc.) to their students at the Get-Away. Teachers will be provided with the email addresses of their students so they may contact the students and take pre-orders of specialty items prior to the get-away if they wish.
- Class size: Maximum number of students per class is 15. If you have a minimum of 8 students enrolled in your class at the registration deadline, you are under contract to teach that class. If there are less than 8 students enrolled, it will be your choice whether to teach the class or not.
- Class fee: Teachers will receive \$15.00 per student for a 3-hour class and \$25.00 per student for a 6-hour class. Teachers receive class fees for all registered students including any "no shows".

Voting takes place online and at our April paint-in (April 25, 2020). You will be notified about the results by April 30, 2020.
