Education Hints from...:

Bonnie Dominguez

1. What is that Santa beard going to look like? Take a piece of tracing paper or vellum (anything you can see through) and lay it on top of Santa's painted face. Paint the beard/mustache right onto the tracing paper or vellum. Keep practicing until you like the beard...then reproduce it on your piece...no fuss, no muss!
2. Use the end of a toothpick for "snow drops" on a background in lieu of spattering.
3. When using "weathered wood" or any crackle medium product...apply the paint liberally on top of the crackle in an up and down pattern for a weathered and cracked wood look. If you want a more uncontrolled, eggshell look, apply liberal paint with a sponge. The heavier the paint on the first (only) application, the larger the cracks.
4. Spray stencils with "Awesome" from the 99 cent store to clean.
5. Make any metallic color by mixing highly pigmented DecoArt Media Fluid acrylics with Metallic Silver.

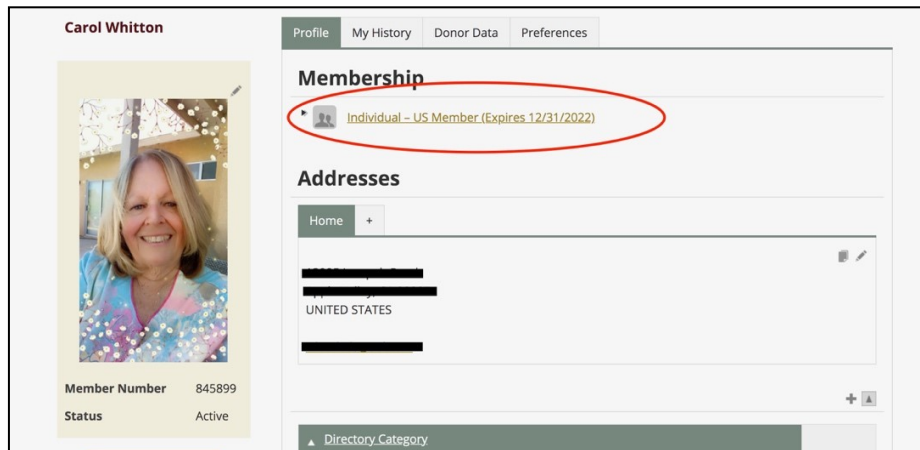

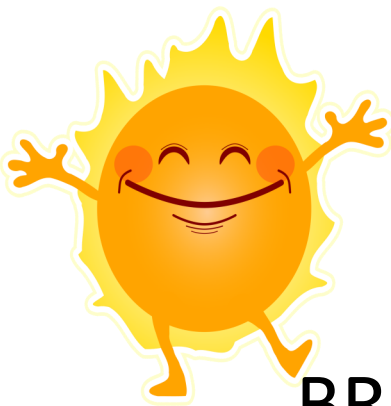
