
Until that can happen, I'll just enjoy the beautiful weather in Southern California and keep my brushes moving.

Hello Gypsies:




so smart!!!

April Membership Report for Gypsy Tolergram



2021 San Bernardino County Fair May 29-31 and June 4-6, 2021

YES! The San Bernardino County Fair will take place this year as a virtual event! We don't have ALL of the information just yet but here's what we do know.


- 1. Residents of San Bernardino County and adjacent counties are eligible to submit entries.
- Entries will be accepted ONLINE ONLY. Go to https://sberna.fairwire.com/ to begin the registration process. The registration deadline is April 9, 2021.
- 3. ALL entry fees are \$1.00 per entry and are payable at the time of entering online.
- 4. There is a limit of three entries per registrant.
- You will be required to upload a photograph of your item/entry to be used during the virtual event.
- 6. This year, you will choose one of three categories to enter your items under:
 - a. Holiday
 - b. Home Decorations
 - c. Any Other
- Entries must be handcrafted by the exhibitor and have been completed within or after May 2019. NOTE: Save your entries for this year as you will be allowed to reenter them for the 2022 San Bernardino County Fair.
- 8. Indicate approximate size of your piece on entry form.
- 11. Entries will be judged "in person." You will be notified of the time and place to drop off Entries will be judged "in person." You will be notified of the time and place to drop off your entries for judging. They will be kept for approximately 1 week. If you have difficulty in getting your entry to or from the fair, contact Carol Whitton (760-954-6533) or Annette Lamarre (760-617-8755) and arrangements will be made to pick up and return your projects.
- 9. There will be no "Premium" prizes (cash) this year. Only ribbons will be awarded.

TIP Chat:

To fill the very rough cross-grain areas of wood that show up on the blunt end of wood (or on beveled wood edges), paint on wood filler that has been thinned with LOTS of water so that it soaks into the rough grain.

Dry and repeat several times or as needed. (Un-thinned filler tends to ride atop the rough wood and flakes off immediately when sanded. The watery filler will soak down into every pore and be solidly smooth.)
