

Carmelita Brooker: Ways and Means;

President, Heidi Allison:

Began meeting by greeting and thanking all attendees. Hello 2022!

Gave update in regards to renewing contract at Redlands Community Center. She received pricing from Michael and is awaiting a new rental agreement to confirm the prices she was given verbally. Current price stated is \$27.00 per hour, with overtime for hours incurred after 7:00 pm at a rate of \$47.00 Yucaipa Community Center may be another option if we are unable to secure Redlands Community Center, however, Redlands is preferred and it will depend on the pricing outlined in the contract.

Confirmed new schedule for future board meetings to be the 2nd Thursday of the month at 6:00 pm.

Treasurer, Jolene Cooley:

Current balance of funds is between \$11,000 and \$12,000. All known debts have been paid including all vendors for Heritage sale and Christmas party. Storage is paid through July. Suggested we through the storage unit, organize, and see if we can downsize. We currently pay \$130.00 per month for unit.

Bank Account needs to be updated with new signers. Heidi, Jolene and Judy to meet at National bank and update signers. New signers to include; Heidi, Jolene, and Carol and former board members removed. The original paperwork for 501c3 also needs to be located. Judy Coates suggested their may be some books in storage that contain the original paperwork. Heidi to contact Sue and see if she can point us in right direction where original paperwork may be.

Jolene would like the accounts audited for transparency. They have not been audited for a couple of years per Judy. Ursula to assist Jolene in auditing.

Heidi has a few Tax liability questions:

How do we handle the PayPal account? Currently PayPal is set up as a not for profit with Jolene as Officer. It is not a personal account.

Do we need to start 1099 teachers? Jolene to find out new level for 2022. Perhaps in future teachers will need to be 1099'd as part of their contract and disclosed up front. Judy suggested they may need to be 1099'd for project surfaces and pattern packets as well as teaching time. She stated it is their job to prove their expenses. Jolene will look into breaking it out in the future. Per Heidi, moving forward we will make sure to follow protocols established.

All reimbursement and income forms that Jolene has received have been completed. Checks that are received by Janet for membership will be included on the form and returned to Jolene. Any member who needs to be reimbursed for money spent will need to complete and return a form with their receipts.

1st Vice President, Programs Reported by Heidi Allison on behalf of Carol Whitton

- Judy and Debbie have opened their shops for members to do programs at for free as we have not had a meeting place. Carol suggested we pay them for use of their shops. Janet Motioned that we pay each shop owner \$50.00 each for the use of their shop. Heidi motioned to vote; motion was carried.
- Upcoming teachers include; Heidi Allison January, Bonnie Dominguez February, Jeanetta Cimo March, Sue Clark April, Janet Mitchell June, Judy Coats August, and Debbie Ramo November.
- Carol has suggested a Mystery Teacher for one month. Maybe charge a little more for this class. Surface may be on our own. Sounds fun. Board is open to this idea.
- Carol will be hosting our next class on January 20, 2022. Members to log in at 5:45 pm for club business meeting, paint class to start at 6:00 pm. Teachers will be updated on our format for classes they will be teaching.



- Submissions are due April 11, 2022
- To submit: Email a high-resolution image (jpeg format) and project description information sheet (see next page) for each submission to <u>ceceliapaints@aol.com</u> with <u>AGA Teacher Submission</u> in the subject line of the email. We recommend your project photo be taken with proper lighting, contrasting background and full-frame (as close-up as possible with minimal background showing). Up to 3 photos per project may be submitted to show all project sides.
- If you are unable to submit your project by email, please mail a 4" x 6" quality photo and project description information sheet (see next page) to:

- Project selection: Projects are voted on by the Brush Whacker members and the projects that receive
 the most votes are offered at the Get-Away.
- Project fee: For all classes that are selected, teachers are required to provide students with prepped surfaces, patterns, instructions, photos, class paint and any materials needed to complete the project (i.e., glue, DecoPage, screws, hanging wire, material for bows, etc.). Teachers should include the cost of these items in their project fee. Project fees are paid directly to teachers by their students at the Get-Away.
- Specialty items: Teachers should list any specialty items students need to bring to class on the project
 description information sheet. Teachers may sell specialty items (stencils, stamps, brushes, etc.) to
 their students at the Get-Away. Teachers will be provided with the email addresses of their students
 so they may contact the students and take pre-orders of specialty items prior to the get-away if they
 wish.
- Class size: Maximum number of students per class is 15. If you have a minimum of 8 students enrolled
 in your class at the registration deadline, you are under contract to teach that class. If there are less
 than 8 students enrolled, it will be your choice whether to teach the class or not.
- Class fee: Teachers will receive \$15.00 per student for a 3-hour class and \$25.00 per student for a 6-hour class. Teachers receive class fees for all registered students including any "no shows".
- Classroom: Teachers will need to bring any equipment they wish to use to teach (i.e., camera, projector, screen, extension cords, power strips, etc.). Tables will be provided by the resort. All classes will be held in a large ballroom. Students will be seated two to a table. A staging area will be available to store your class materials. Please label your boxes clearly.
