

I'm excited to share that we have again decided to support Angel's Closet as our philanthropic cause this year! I had the great pleasure of speaking to their administrator recently and she is so excited that we are coming back to help them. For those who aren't familiar with Angel's Closet, I'd like to share a little of what I learned. The mission of Angel's Closet is to "keep kids in school". You may think, what's the big deal, but in thinking about today's challenges for kids and families, sometimes this isn't always easy. It saddens me to think of the number of kids living on the streets, living out of a car, living in a shelter, growing up in foster care, or just living with a family that is having a tough time making ends meet. Angel's Closet tries to help fill in the gap by providing some of the necessities these kids need that just might make the difference of that kid staying in school or dropping out.

Angel's Closet is located at Redlands East Valley High School. They provide support to middle school and high school students in the Redlands and San Bernardino Unified School Districts. Kids get referred to Angel's Closet by their school counselor, teacher, school security, social worker or foster agency. The charity is always in need of gently used clothing suitable for middle and high school kids. Kids receive five outfits, a coat and shoes initially. They can then go back to supplement their wardrobe needs. Angel's Closet continues to support the kids in their program if they go on to college as well as their journey to employment. Clothes are provided for job interviews if needed. In the Spring, formal wear is there for kids wanting to go to Prom, but don't have the means to get Prom attire. As you can see, this organization is providing a vital service to the community and can use our support to continue their mission.

On an ongoing basis, Angel's Closet is always in need of the basic necessities: new underwear and socks (boys and girls), shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, toothbrushes and toothpaste. Make-up and cologne are nice added extras. They are in need of all sizes from small to XXL. The boys like boxer briefs best and the girls like anything other than "granny panties". And if it's easier, monetary donations are always welcome.

Another need is smaller luggage pieces in good condition. Angel's Closet provides luggage to foster kids for them to keep their belongings in. I'm sure you have heard the stories of foster kids many times just having a trash bag to carry their clothes and other belongings in as they move from one location to another.

Angel's Closet is a 501(c)3 organization. Your donations are tax deductible. You can help us support them by donating items, or you can make a monetary donation which will be used to buy the items needed for these kids. If you wish to make a monetary donation, please make your check payable to Angel's Closet and send it to my attention: Regina Taylor, 705 S. California Avenue, West Covina, CA 91790. If you wish to donate items, you can drop them off at O'Flanary's in Redlands or at Allison Mechanical—look for the box in the lobby to leave your donation. Please attach your name to your donation—we will be holding a drawing every other month for those who have donated to Angel's Closet!

On a monthly basis we will focus on providing specific items needed by Angel's Closet. You are always free to donate other items as anything is appreciated. For the month of March, we will be collecting socks. Crew length or those short kind that don't show are probably the most popular. In addition to white, I would bet colors and "fun" socks would also be appreciated. I know all of my grandkids get a kick out of the "fun" socks I buy them! My grandson wears dinosaurs, Big Foot, basketball, Scoobie Doo and other fun designs.

I hope you are as excited as I am to join with Angel's Closet to help these kids out. It is so hard in today's society sometimes to "fit in"...let's band together and do what we can to help. THANKS FOR YOUR SUPPORT!!

# San Diego Brush Whackers 38th Annual Autumn Get-Away

Wednesday-Friday, September 13-15, 2023
Viejas Casino → Resort
Alpine, California

This event is always full of fantastic classes, food, fun, friendship, a great raffle, and lots of laughter!

We would like to invite you to submit projects to teach at the Get-Away. This is an *in-person* event. Classes will be held Wednesday through Friday and are for all levels of painters. Submissions using various painting mediums (acrylics, waterColors, pencils, mixed media, etc.) are welcome.

#### Here are the details:

- Submissions are due by April 8, 2023
- To submit: Email a high-resolution image (jpeg format) and project description information sheet (see next page) for each submission to <u>ceceliapaints@aol.com</u> with <u>AGA Teacher Submission</u> in the subject line of the email. We recommend your project photo be taken with proper lighting, contrasting background and full-frame (as close-up as possible with minimal background showing). Up to 3 photos per project may be submitted to show all project sides.
- If you are unable to submit your project by email, please mail a 4" x 6" quality photo and project description information sheet (see next page) to:

- Project selection: Projects are voted on by the Brush Whacker members and the projects that receive
  the most votes are offered at the Get-Away.
- Project fee: For all classes that are selected, teachers are required to provide students with prepped surfaces, patterns, instructions, photos, class paint and any materials needed to complete the project (i.e., glue, DecoPage, screws, hanging wire, material for bows, etc.). Teachers should include the cost of these items in their project fee. Project fees are paid directly to teachers by their students at the Get-Away.
- Specialty items: Teachers should list any specialty items students need to bring to class on the project
  description information sheet. Teachers may sell specialty items (stencils, stamps, brushes, etc.) to
  their students at the Get-Away. Teachers will be provided with the email addresses of their students
  so they may contact the students and take pre-orders of specialty items prior to the get-away if they
  wish.
- Class size: Maximum number of students per class is 15. If you have a minimum of 8 students enrolled
  in your class at the registration deadline, you are under contract to teach that class. If there are less
  than 8 students enrolled, it will be your choice whether to teach the class or not.
- Class fee: Teachers will receive \$15.00 per student for a 3-hour class and \$25.00 per student for a 6-hour class. Teachers receive class fees for all registered students including any "no shows".
- Classroom: Teachers will need to bring any equipment they wish to use to teach (i.e., camera, projector, screen, extension cords, power strips, etc.). Tables will be provided by the resort. All classes will be held in a large ballroom. Students will be seated two to a table. A staging area will be available to store your class materials. Please label your boxes clearly.
- Registration: We would love for our teachers to participate in the entire event, including classes, lodging, and meals. The painting room fees are covered by meeting our hotel and food guarantees.
- Please email me with any questions about individual meal or room costs.
- A mileage reimbursement is not provided.
- Teachers may submit projects for up to 15 hours of class time...3-hour & 6-hour blocks.

Submissions are voted on by the San Diego Brush Whacker membership, using your photo and description alone, so please be detailed about size, surface, medium and include a high-resolution image or quality photograph for each submission. Voting will take place online from April 15 – 23, 2023. You will be notified of the results by April 25, 2023.

I hope you will consider sharing your talent with us! This event averages 65 painters which includes our members, along with painters from other clubs. Feel free to email Cecelia with any questions or concerns. We am looking forward to hearing from you!
