As I write this little note to you, I pray you have found a cure for the cabin fever we have all been through the last few months.

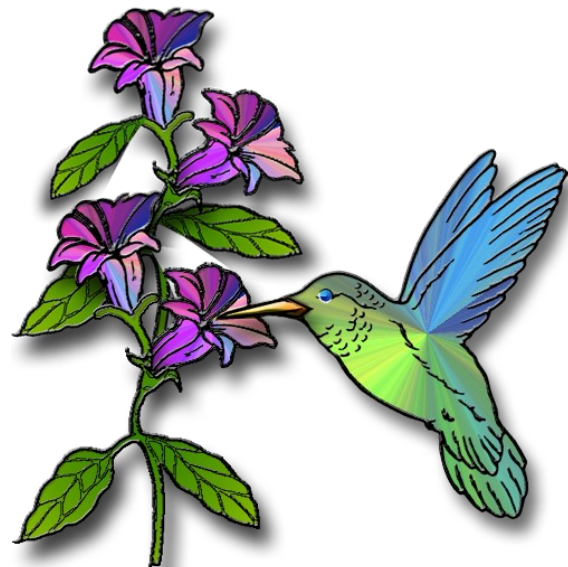
We are now surrounded by Spring and the amazing lazy days of Summer are just ahead of us.

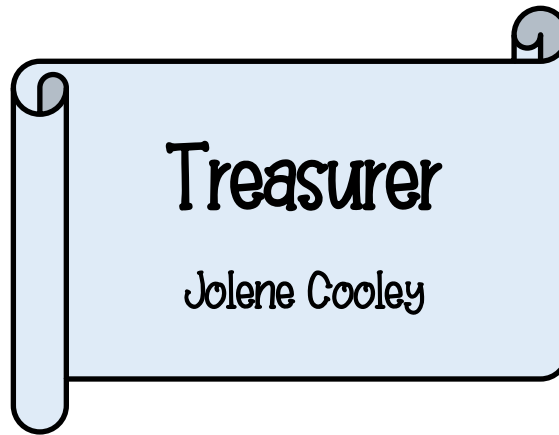

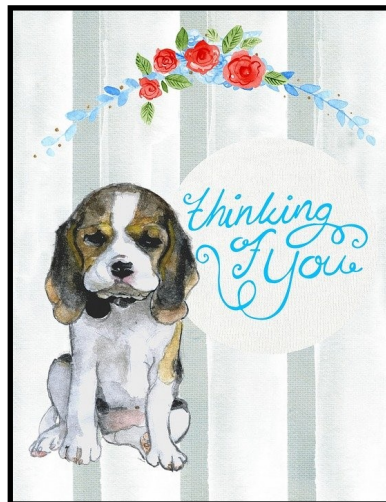
