May you all have the most wonderful holiday season with friends and family!



## **Education Hints from...:**

## Bonnie Dominguez

- 1. Put a dot of liquid glass on your palette, and take a dot on a stylus anddot onto your piece where you want a crystal. Pick up a crystal and place it on top.
- 2. Check out ArtGlitter.com
- 3. Use DecoArt Matte Medium as a "Resist". Lay down a stencil and apply matte medium on with a stencil brush. Let it completely dry. The matte medium will resist where the paint goes. Paint...and wipe away paint with a dry paper towel. If y ou want to soften more—wipe off with a baby wipe...what is left is a very cool effect.
- 4. To create a "rusty" background, just remember to "hammer and burn it"! Stipple with hammered iron, burnt umber and burnt sienna.
- 5. Use Murphy's Oil Soap to clean brushes...especially if they have dried paint in the feral.
