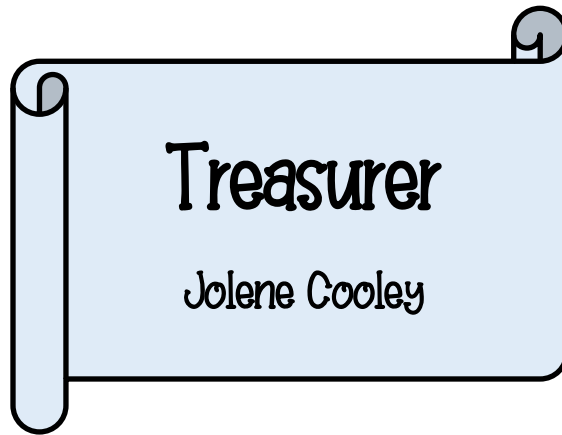

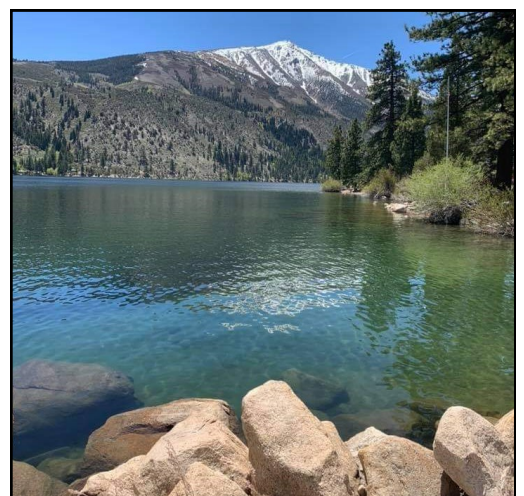

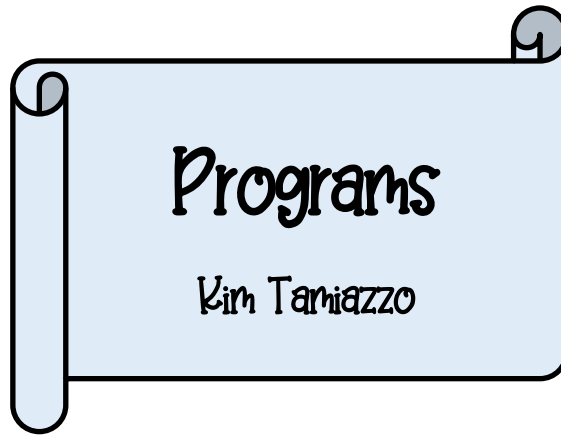
Pixie doesn't get to go on this trip as she's still in training and I'm sure she would want to play with the bears or deer that will be there! Can't take a chance yet.

I wish you all happiness and know this will be over soon! Much love—Cheryl Jones, Secretary



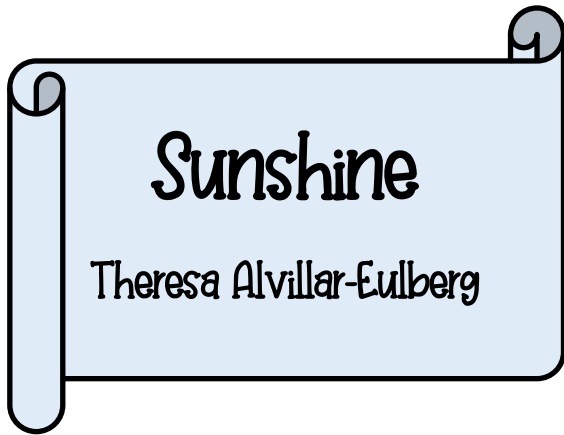


GYPSY TOLERS *SEPT.* PROJECT

Time to think outside the box and use a surface you have in your stash. Terri has 14 surfaces, if you want this particular surface it is available from CD Wood

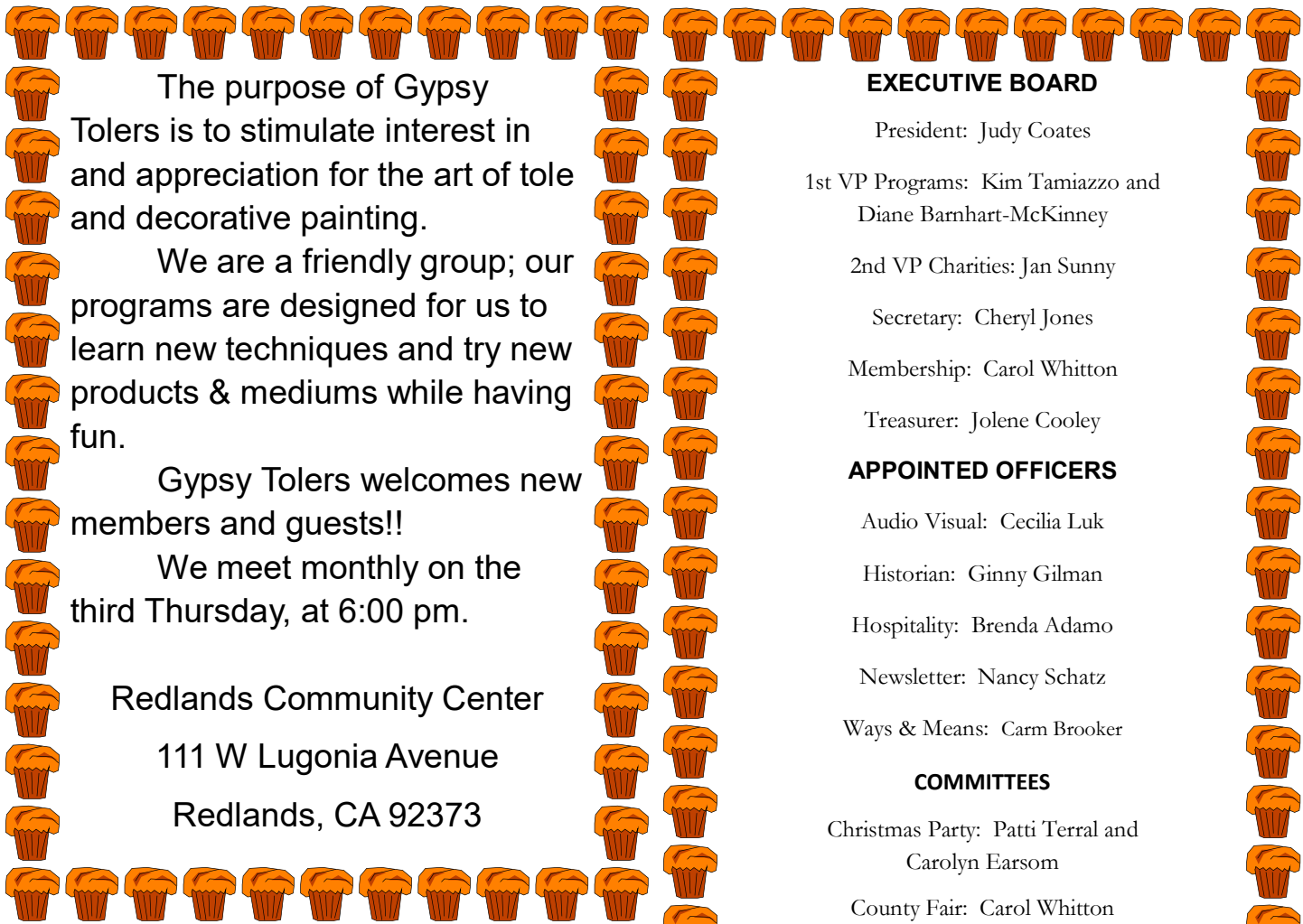
Once your payment is received prep instructions will be emailed to you.
