

IT'S A MYSTERY

November 21, 2024 Project Judy Coates, Teacher

At this time our November project is a mystery.

Several members, knowing Judy is the teacher, have already signed up.

You may do so as well or wait until information about the project is published.



I know many of you are busy painting for boutiques, club programs, or just for fun. Why not set aside one of your "multiples" to enter in the 2025 Fair? I've mentioned before that I organize my finished projects into three tubs - one for boutique items, one for gifts, and one for Fair entries. If I'm being honest, I also have a 4th tub for my UFOs (unfinished objects)! But back to the three tubs –this system makes it so easy to pull out the right tub when the time comes.

Painters of all levels are invited to participate. I've heard our newer painters say, "I don't paint that well," but let me address that. First, each division (see below) competes against painters of similar skill levels, and second, we all started out as beginners. For the past two years, we haven't had any entries for Beginners which is why we need you! This coming year, painters who have traditionally entered in the Intermediate division are moving on to Advanced, so, we especially need members who have less than 1-10 years of experience to join in. I know you're out there!

So that you are able to begin planning to enter projects this year, the Division and various Class definitions are listed below. Remember, it's okay to subject more than one project in a Class. Just remember that when you do, you'll be competing against yourself for that Class (i.e. I submit two projects in Class 26 – Halloween. My two projects are the only projects submitted in that Class. I might receive one blue ribbon and one red ribbon then. I could not receive two blue ribbons). So, Happy Painting! Let's have an even greater showing for 2025!

DIVISION

- BEGINNER: Painted 1-3 years
- INTERMEDIATE: Painted 4-9 years
- ADVANCED: Knowledge in the art and/or painted 10+ years
- PROFESSIONAL: Paints for a livelihood rather than a hobby (i.e. teachers, designers, etc)
